

6.72 – SIGNS AND DISPLAYS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

Non-commercial signs and displays will fall into two categories:

1. Donations of property subject to Board Policy 6.03, Public Gifts and Donations to the Schools; or
2. Temporary signs and displays placed for a specific time period and approved by the superintendent or the superintendent's designee. The school district does not assume ownership of temporary signs and displays and will not be responsible for loss due to theft, vandalism, or any other cause.

Student- made signs and displays shall be approved by the school principal or the principal's designee before being placed on school property.
