

SAFETY TIPS FOR SCHOOL BUS RIDERS

- 1. Always remain seated correctly, not on knees, not on backpack while the bus is in motion. Always face forward when riding the bus.**
- 2. When talking, talk in a soft tone of voice. Always be aware of the noise level.**
- 3. Always obey the school bus driver – They are your Teacher on that Bus!**
- 4. Always watch your step and utilize the handrail when loading and unloading.**
- 5. Always wait for the driver to motion you across the roadways, provided you must cross the roadways. Always cross in front of the bus.**
- 6. Always watch for the snagging of drawstrings and straps on book bags as you unload from the bus.**
- 7. Always be aware of the danger zone. Take 10 giant steps away from the bus.**
- 8. Always keep the aisle of bus clear of your feet, books, lunch box and book bag.**
- 9. Always get on and off the bus in a single file. No pushing or horseplay.**
- 10. Never put your head, arms, or anything out the window.**
- 11. Never throw anything inside or outside the bus.**
- 12. Never walk behind or along the side of the bus.**
- 13. If you drop something near the bus, tell the bus driver. Never try to pick it up because the driver may not be able to see you. Never crawl under the bus.**
- 14. All school Handbook Rules are to be followed.**
